## Pacific Tower

*Located on 1200 12th Avenue South Seattle, WA 98144, this space features two public entrances to the Pacific Tower: the main entrance, located on the South side of the building (Level 1), and the North entrance (Level B). ADA accessibility is through North entrance of building.*

*ADA parking is located in the West Garage on Level P1 (enter building through north entrance), and as you enter on 14th Ave., around the flagpole circle in front of the south main entrance. Street parking is also available.*

## Othello-UW Commons

*The Othello-UW Commons is located on the street level with entrance steps. Our bathrooms are wheelchair accessible and are located in the lobby of the Assembly 118 apartments that we share the ground floor with. There are no stairs to the restrooms. One of the bathrooms are for females and the other is an all-gender single room.*

*Two of our three event spaces, studios A and B, are on the ground floor. Our conference room is located on our mezzanine, up a flight of eighteen stairs, and is accessible by using an elevator in the lobby of Assembly 118. All parking is street parking, and currently there are no designated parking spaces.*

*The space is accessible by Bus & Light Rail. Free Parking is also available and includes designated ADA parking in the parking lot. The entrances feature automatic doors at all main entryways. All levels of the library are accessible through an elevator. Accessibility toolkits with adaptive equipment are available to help people who are blind or low vision use computers and other Library resources.*

*In compliance with the Washington State Law Against Discrimination (WLAD), the Americans with Disability Act (ADA), and the Seattle Municipal Code, service animals are welcome in all areas of the Library where members of the public are normally allowed to go.*

*Parking is available as well in lots E-19 and E-21, adjacent to the WAC, at a fee of \$4.00/hour or \$18.00 for all day.*

*The Mount Baker Center meeting spaces features an upper-floor room with two decks with stair and elevator access and two televisions for AV needs. An adjacent building has a smaller-sized meeting room with an overlook deck. This 2nd-floor space is accessible via a flight of stairs.*

*There is an elevator going from the lobby to the upper floor. Access to two unisex restrooms on the same floor for patron's exclusive use, as well as availability upon request of additional restrooms and changing areas at the ground level. The center has 91 parking spaces which are on a first come, first serve basis.*
